At 1:00 p.m., as the second part of the problem statement was released, the teams began working on their innovative solutions. They were equipped with internet access and necessary charging-related hardware.











These are just as important as technical skills for professional success in the new world of work. In fact the World Economic Forum ranks these amongst top 10 job skills for jobs of the future and India's new national education policy lays special emphasis on them.

XBSL's goal is to partner with colleges teaching coding / computer science degrees and identify cohorts of qualifying girls to put them through the XBSL 21st century workplace skills development program along with sessions on personality development, grooming and confidence building.
