NOTICE

As per the resolution passed in 5th academic council meeting held on March 27th, following rules will be applicable from Academic year 2026-27

1. The evaluation is modified as (ISE: 20 marks, MSE: 30 Marks and ESE: 50 marks). ISE activities will be conducted during the entire semester. MSE will be a written summative examination of 30 marks based on 50% syllabus for 90 minutes. ESE examination will be a written summative examination for 50 marks based on the full syllabus (20% questions on syllabus covered before MSE and 80% questions on the remaining syllabus) for 120 minutes.
2. Self-learning hours include MOOCs, spoken tutorials, online resources, and extended study hours to enhance independent learning and better understanding of each module of the course content. Evaluation of the self-learning components is carried out in all the evaluation components.
3. The Special and Re-examination will be a written summative examination for 80 marks based on the full syllabus for 180 minutes (3 Hours).
4. There is a **separate head of passing for End Semester Examination (ESE)** i.e. minimum 40% marks to be scored in ESE and total of ISE+ MSE+ ESE should be 40 on the scale of 100 to clear the subject.
5. Laboratory ISE is divided into two components: 25 marks for performance and submission of experiments and 25 marks for Oral/Practical evaluation.
6. For all the students appearing for special examination, the attendance for the remedial lectures is **compulsory**. Only those students whose attendance is satisfactory will be allowed to fill the form for Special examination.

Kindly take a note of above changes which will be applicable from Academic year 2026-27.
